Local Advocacy: supports members building local power at the worksite and district levels to win pay raises, improvements to benefits, and better working conditions

Board of Trustee Elections: supports local candidates for governing boards while engaging in political mobilization

Share My Lesson: offers a national database with over 420,000 free, educator-developed lesson plans and activities

First Book: partners to provide free books and classroom resources, distributing nearly 3 million books to Texas Title I schools

Legislative Advocacy: organizes the largest statewide movement of school employees to hold elected officials accountable, mobilizing more than 25,000 educators and allies in the last legislative session

Student Loan Relief: hosts Student Debt Clinics and a free benefit (Summer) to lower educators' student loan costs

Labor Rights: advocates for collective bargaining rights while engaging in elected consultation agreements locally

Employee-Focused: represents teachers and staff only — not administrators

Community Schools: promotes Community Schools Model for neighborhood public schools with wraparound services

Local Support: has more local and regional offices and staff than any other educator organization in Texas

National Support: affiliated with a national organization

Union Strong: affiliated with the 12.5 million-member AFL-CIO
