
One Billionaire is Buying Our Schools—And It's Costing You!



This graph represents the millions Jeff Yass along with his billionaire friends have spent to buy influence in the state legislature. The red dots represent the legislative seats they were able influence! Yass is funding politicians who support school vouchers.

Quick snapshot

- Who is Jeff Yass?
 - An out-of-state billionaire who spends millions to push school vouchers across four states including Texas.
- What's the problem?
 - Vouchers take public school money and give it to private schools
- Why does it matter?
 - o Public schools lose funding, teachers, and resources while Yass profits.

Key Facts

- **\$90 million**—How much Yass and his billionaire friends have spent on influencing our state legislators and pushing school vouchers.
- **Public schools lose out**—Vouchers take tax dollars meant for *all* kids and give them to private schools that can reject students and serve children already attending private schools

• Who suffers? Local schools, especially in low-income and rural areas. Public dollars being funded into private schools via vouchers means fewer teachers and school staff, larger class sizes and fewer resources, forcing public schools to close while private schools profit of our tax dollars.
